Background

- Visual Slickedit presented at 1998
 Symposium in RTP
- Follow up presentation of Object Rexx support by Allen Richardson in 2002
- Work continued by Rony Flatscher following the Symposium
- Allen left the company and no one picked up his Rexx work

Built-in Rexx Support

- *.cmd files recognized as "Rexx"
 - Must have a comment (/* */) on first line
- Code completion incomplete
 - several keywords missing
 - some support wrong
- Keyword highlighting very flawed
 - many keywords included that are NOT Rexx
 - other keywords/BIFs missing
